

Code of Conduct

The EPIC5 Code of Conduct establishes standards by which athletes, crew and staff are expected to conduct themselves. We are required to abide by these standards at all times whilst participating in EPIC5 Events and when engaging in any manner with associated media contact.

- We shall keep our own safety and the safety of others as our paramount focus and responsibility at all times during the duration of the EPIC5 Event.
- We shall respect and obey all applicable laws and regulations with respect to our conduct at all times during the EPIC5 Event.
- We shall refrain from any unsportsmanlike conduct.
- We shall treat fellow athletes, staff, volunteers, and spectators with respect and courtesy, free of objectionable material and profanity.
- We shall ensure that all discussions and comments relating to EPIC5 are consistent and appropriate with stated values and policies of the EPIC5 brand.
- We shall avoid the use of abusive behavior whether verbal, physical or sexual.
- We shall respect the property of other athletes, staff, volunteers, and spectators, as well as that of members of the communities within which any EPIC5 Event occurs.
- We shall demonstrate respect and gratitude to the communities within which any EPIC5 Event occurs, remembering to minimize our individual and EPIC5 Event footprint upon these communities with respect to debris, litter, noise and motor vehicle pollution, and overall physical presence.
- **We shall ensure** that all forms of communication – i.e., social media content, written, photographic, audio— affords respect to all individuals, communities and organizations involved in the EPIC5 Event and brand.
- We shall accept any and all personal liability for any comments and material that may be deemed to be defamatory.
- Athletes shall follow the prescribed courses. and cover the prescribed courses in their entirety. If an athlete must exit the course, he or she shall re-enter the course at the same point of departure before continuing.
- We shall refrain from possessing or using all non-legally prescribed drugs or alcohol while present on any of the prescribed courses, traveling during the EPIC5 Event or when otherwise publicly representing any EPIC5 Event.
